Team A or Team B is designated as A or B

Team A or Team B's 45 yard-lines, example: A-45 or B-45

Player A or B's number is 40, example: A40 or B40

Second down and 6 yards to go for A at the B 23 yard-line, example: A, 2/6, B-23

The Kicking or Receiving teams are designated as K or R

Team K or Team R's 45 yard-lines, example: K-45 or R-45

Player K or R's number is 65, example: K65 or R65

Fourth down and 12 yards to go for K at the R 45 yard-line, example: K, 4/12, R-45

BSB - blind side block

NZ - neutral zone

BIB - block in the back

UC – unsportsmanlike conduct

KCI - kick catch interference

PSK - post-scrimmage kick

FBZ - free blocking zone

UC – unsportsmanlike conduct

LOS - line of scrimmage

OB - out of bounds

1. A, 3/10, A-20. Quarterback A12 is back to pass. As he throws the ball forward to eligible receiver A87, B66 bats the ball and it is recovered by A62 at the A24.

15. A, 2/8, B-40. As A15 is calling signals, B62 breaks into the neutral zone and A67 lifts his hand to block B62 before the snap.

 - Charge B with a timeout and have B44 go to the sideline to get his hip pads
 - Officials timeout. B44 must leave the game for at least one down until his missing equipment is properly worn

20. A, 1/10, A-33. At the snap, A67 blocks down on B62 below the waist and from behind at the A-34 in the free blocking zone. A44 runs to the A-40.
- Legal because it is in the free blocking zone. A, 2/3, A-40
 - Clipping. A, 1/25, A-18
 - Block in the back. A, 1/20, A-23
21. A, 3/6, A-42. A14 is scrambling at the A-36 and throws a pass to A87 at the A-49. During the scramble, A62 holds B75 at the A-40.
- Legal because the blocker and the passer were behind the LOS
 - Holding, ES is the previous spot
 - Holding, ES is the end of the run
 - Holding, ES is the spot of the foul
22. A, 3/10, B-40. A12 pitches the ball backwards to A23 at the B-47. A23 runs to the B-42 and throws a pass to A86 at the B-30. A86 catches the ball and runs to the B-20 where he is hit and fumbles. B30 recovers the ball at the B-18 while contacting the sideline.
- B, 1/10, B-18
 - A, 1/10, B-18
 - A, 4/10, B-40
 - A, 1/10, B-20
23. K, 4/12, K-25. K52 punts the ball from the K-12. R44, thinking his team has only 10 players, enters the field at the K-40 as the 12th player and legally blocks K87 at the K-42. R21 catches the kick at the R-45 and returns it to the K-40 where he is tackled.
