Annual Business Meeting April 7, 2018 - Minutes

- President Betty Siwinski called the Business Meeting to order during the Annual Banquet, which was held at Tony & Penny's Restaurant in Ludlow. Betty thanked everyone for coming.
- 2. Betty expressed thanks to the ride coordinators, Janet Parslow and Ted Jeremicz. She also thanked the ride leaders who volunteered, calling out Diane and Kerry Goguen who led the first club ride of the season in very cold weather.
- 3. Treasurer's Report Les Prentice: After paying the banquet expenses of \$900, the club treasury will contain \$1,599 in available funds. Les noted that dues were \$5 per year in 1989 and that memberships at that time were almost the same as the current number.

- 4. Betty recognized Les for his 30-year milestone as Club Treasurer. In appreciation, Betty presented Les with a desk clock which contained a plaque noting his service. Mary Ann Siron also created a large card with photos which was signed by those present.
- 5. Membership Report Ken Paquette: We finished 2017 with 132 members. So far in 2018, we have 103 memberships comprised of 90 single, 11 family, and 14 life memberships. Thirty-four memberships are currently unpaid.
- 6. Annual Picnic We need a volunteer to host the picnic.
