If anyone is willing to try and sell more tickets, PLEASE reach out to me and I will be more that happy to send them to you!



Greetings Auxiliary Sisters,

As we venture into Fall, things begin to get busier and busier as the Holidays approach. It is important to be mindful of due dates for Service Reports. Department Officers also have due dates to send to National. Mid Year reports are due to the Dept Officers Oct 25th. A Mid Year and End of Year has to be sent to be eligible for awards on the Dept and National levels.

As Dept Secretary, I also am responsible for membership. Membership year goes from January 1st to December 31st. Start your renewal reminders now. Any member paying dues to their Local after Dec 31st is considered new/rejoin so as to keep their present Aux ID #. This helps National keep a record of actual new members. Renew to Life- an annual member that choses to become a Life member. New to Life- is an actual new member that has joined the Auxiliary, and choses to pay Life member membership dues one time of 325.00. Honorary-voted on annually. An honorary member has no way of joining, but shows an interest in volunteering in Auxiliary functions, and has an interest in the goals of AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary.

New members- I need a copy of their application they filled out. This is to verify their membership, and that they are joining under an AMVET, or deceased Veteran. (father, grandfather). Must be signed by the AMVETS Post membership Officer.

ALL donations to National, or Department, are sent to Dept Secretary, Mary Lanphere, 6310 E Main Rd., Portland NY 14769. Be sure to specify where the donations are going. Donations are to be made out to AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary Dept of NY. Dept secretary will send out forms for donations. One form specifically for National Programs, (St Jude's, John Tracy Center, PAWS With A Cause, National President's Project, Parke Scholarship, National Scholarship, Freedoms Foundation). A second form is for Dept donations. (Dept Presidents Project, & Rose Baldwin Memorial Scholarship). Donations can be sent at any time to Dept Secretary, but no later than May 1st, to ensure your donations will be entered in the National Convention book. Remember to credit your donations on your Service Reports.

Nyamvetsladiesaux.org is our website. Please utilize it for information, as well as the National Ladies Auxiliary website. Up to date forms are found on both sites. Throw out any outdated forms you have at your Auxiliary.

The following should be included in your Bylaws:

- 1.) Official name and number of your Auxiliary
- 2.) Principal address of your Auxiliary
- 3.) Aims and Purposes
- 4.) Membership
- 5.) Officers
- 6.) Quorum
- 7.) Meetings/Trainings
- 8.) Annual Dues and Life Membership
- 9.) Executive Committee
- 10.) Discipline and Rights of Appeal
- 11.)Amendments
- 12.) Roberts Rules of Order

I am suggesting that you have one meeting a year to discuss your Bylaws and Standing Rules, along with your own training with your President getting questions out of your Manual. Knowledge brings good Officers and Members. Your Training Committee requires a training every 3 years and your Bylaws and Standing Rules are due to your Department Parliamentarian every 3 years with 3 copies sent.

VAVS Bath Fall Bulletin 2022

Happy Fall Y'all to all of my VA Hospital supporters. Unfortunately, the Bath VA still will not let volunteers onsite to help the Veterans. However, I do manage to sneak in (Ha Ha) with donations.

I have been very fortunate to have support for our VA from two local churches, some Auxiliaries, and the Student Veterans at St. Bonaventure University. Also, this week a business in Olean, N.Y. which sells Avon has asked if they can be a regular donor of some Avon products for the Bath VA. We are very excited to have McCarthy's Emporium onboard. This week I will be picking up 50-100 containers of deodorant for the VA from McCarthy's.

Coming up at the VA is the Veteran's Art Show/ National Creative Arts Festival. Judging will be next month to see who goes onto Nationals.
