

RELIGIOUS STUDIES 15 SERVICE PROJECT

A service project is an opportunity to put our faith into action. During the semester students must complete 10 hours of service that assists people who are in need or builds their faith. Students can fulfill this requirement by participating in community or church related activities such as the Food Bank, Loaves and Fishes and Friendship meals. They may assist the handicapped, the sick, and those who are abandoned. Small groups may wish to work together and create a project that can aid any of the above organizations.

Check with your teacher to make sure the project you have chosen fits with the criteria of the service requirement. The project should be done outside your family and you should not profit from it financially. For example: Babysitting in most circumstances would not be accepted.
