The Pump - turning it on and turning off

This time last year, lake level was 15" below target level. Our lake augmentation pump has been off since 8/16/2016 when the lake level was 8" below the target level. It is to be turned on in the Spring when the water level is 8" below the normal high water mark.

5/24/2017 lake level is 1" above the target level (target = 4" below high water mark.)

During the Summer it is turned off when the water level reaches 4" below the normal high water mark.
