

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% (220 runs) Paper entries: 67% (440 runs). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 26" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES

Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW, FAST and T2B, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). ELIGIBILITY AND HIEGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all regular classes:

- 8" for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers Preferred class: 4" Preferred class: 8"
- 12" for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 16" for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers Preferred class: 12"
- 20" for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers Preferred class: 16" Preferred class: 20"
- 24" for dogs over 22 inches at the withers
- 26" dogs may be entered at this height at owner's discretion Preferred class: N/A

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all international classes (if offered):

- 14″ for dogs 13-3/4 inches and under at the withers (mini dogs)
- 18″ for dogs 16-7/8 inches and under at the withers (midi dogs)
- 26″ for dogs over 16-7/8 inches at the withers (maxi dogs)

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/26" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/26" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. 
