IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS AND ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS

Rule 24-2 and 25-1

An immovable obstruction is an artificial object on the course that cannot be moved (e.g. a building) or cannot readily be moved (e.g. a firmly embedded distance post). Objects defining out of bounds are not treated as obstructions.

An abnormal ground condition is casual water, ground under repair or a hole, or cast or runway made by a burrowing animal, reptile or a bird.

Except when the ball is in a water hazard, relief without penalty is available from immovable obstructions and abnormal ground conditions when the condition physically interferes with the lie of the ball, your stance or swing. You may lift the ball and drop it within one club length of the nearest point of relief, but not nearer the hole then the nearest point of relief. If the ball is on the putting green, it is placed at the nearest point of relief, which may be off the putting green.
