Sunday's Reflection

Today's Scripture readings emphasize that God is the one who has taken the initiative in our salvation. God has borne us up on eagle wings and made us his special possession - we are a kingdom of priests, God's holy people.

St. Paul is caught up in the wonder of God's love for us: "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us ...When we were God's enemies, God reconciled to himself by the death of his Son."

God is love, and the nature of love is to go outside itself toward others. God not only took the initiative in loving us. In the sacrificial death of Jesus, God proves in an incontestable way that we are loved far beyond any considerations of our worthiness. That is the mind-blowing mystery of our faith: we have been redeemed in total love by a God whose love is completely benevolent. God gains nothing by loving us. We gain everything by being loved by God.

Sometimes we can get too preoccupied with our duties as believers, our obligations as members of the people of God. We forget that God first moved toward us in love. We don't have to seek God; God has found us.

Jesus has reconciled us to God by his death. Our heartfelt acceptance of our reconciliation can lead us to draw confidence from God's boundless love and take greater hold of the life God offers us in Jesus. Our hope is sure. We have good reason to make God our boast every day of our life.

Our lives can become a joyful celebration of the grace that is ours. We are gifted by God's love every day.

What return can we make to the Lord for his gift of love? Nothing better than freely and generously sharing that gift of God's love with everyone we meet. May our thankfulness be evident each day as we choose to be an announcement of God's gracious love in everything we say and do.

Reflexión del domingo

Las lecturas bíblicas de hoy enfatizan que Dios es quien ha tomado la iniciativa en nuestra salvación. Dios nos ha llevado con alas de águila y nos ha hecho su posesión especial: somos un reino de sacerdotes, el pueblo santo de Dios.

San Pablo está atrapado en la maravilla del amor de Dios por nosotros: "Cuando todavía éramos pecadores, Cristo murió por nosotros... Cuando éramos enemigos de Dios, Dios se reconciliaba consigo mismo por la muerte de su Hijo".

Dios es amor, y la naturaleza del amor es salir de sí mismo hacia los demás. Dios no solo tomó la iniciativa de amarnos. En la muerte sacrificial de Jesús, Dios demuestra de manera incontestable que somos amados mucho más allá de cualquier consideración de nuestra dignidad. Ese es el misterio alucinante de nuestra fe: hemos sido redimidos en amor total por un Dios cuyo amor es completamente benevolente. Dios no gana nada amándonos. Ganamos todo al ser amados por Dios.

A veces podemos preocuparnos demasiado con nuestros deberes como creyentes, nuestras obligaciones como miembros del pueblo de Dios. Olvidamos que Dios primero se movió hacia nosotros en amor. No tenemos que buscar a Dios; Dios nos ha encontrado.

Jesús nos ha reconciliado con Dios con su muerte. Nuestra aceptación sincera de nuestra reconciliación puede llevarnos a obtener confianza del amor ilimitado

de Dios y a aferrarnos más a la vida que Dios nos ofrece en Jesús. Nuestra esperanza es segura. Tenemos buenas razones para hacer de Dios nuestra jactancia todos los días de nuestra vida.

Nuestras vidas pueden convertirse en una celebración gozosa de la gracia que es nuestra. Estamos dotados por el amor de Dios todos los días.

¿Qué retorno podemos hacer al Señor por su don de amor? Nada mejor que compartir libre y generosamente ese don del amor de Dios con todos los que conocemos. Que nuestro agradecimiento sea evidente cada día cuando elegimos ser un anuncio del amor misericordioso de Dios en todo lo que decimos y hacemos.


