## WISCONSIN

The Territory of Wisconsin was admitted into the Union as a state in 1848.<sup>1</sup> Originally singledistrict, it was divided into Eastern and Western Districts in 1870 with one judge assigned to each district.<sup>2</sup> At first the court had both district and circuit court jurisdiction, which was restricted to the former when Wisconsin was placed in the Eighth Circuit in 1862. Wisconsin was moved to the Seventh Circuit in 1866, where it remains.

WI.ED.01 is the state's original judgeship (see Judge Miller's succession line), and until the division into two districts, was assigned jurisdiction for the entire state. WI.ED.03 was created as a temporary line in 1966, but converted to permanent four years later.<sup>3</sup> Wisconsin has seven judgeships, five in the Eastern and two in the Western Districts.
