A visit to the doctor's office that a lot of people prolong doing is what started Leah's cancer fight.

On June 18th, 2024, Leah went to the doctor's office with concerns about a lump on her breast. That same day she was able to have a mammogram and an ultrasound. A few days later June 20th, she had a breast biopsy. On June 25th Leah got the news nobody wants to hear. She was diagnosed with stage III invasive ductal carcinoma aka breast cancer. The next few days were filled with meeting with a surgeon and having a PET scan. July 1st, she had her first visit with an oncologist. July 2nd, she had a port inserted for chemo and a few days later met with the oncologist again to gather more baselines. July 11th was the first day of chemo and July 12th she had additional infusions.

Treatment is consisting of chemo for 18 weeks on a 21-day cycle. October 23rd is the last scheduled chemo. That will be followed up with a double mastectomy, possible radiation and hormone therapy for the next 5-10 years. In Leah's words about her treatment plan "It is all worth it to get rid of this shit".
