

The Dept. of Defense announced a policy change that will extend limited online military exchange shopping privileges to all honorably discharged veterans, to become effective on Veterans Day Nov. 11, 2017. This initiative



represents an opportunity to help fund morale, welfare and recreation programs in support of service members' and their family's quality of life. "As a nation we are grateful for the contributions of our service members. Offering this lifetime online benefit is one small, tangible way the nation can say, 'Thank you' to those who have served with honor," said Peter Levine for the undersecretary of defense. 


