Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be getting to know one another and making new relationships as they settle into Nursery. We will be discussing how to resolve conflicts and talking to each other about our interests and strengths.

We will be talking about our School/Nursery rules and discussing how to keep these rules when we are learning and playing.



Communication and Language:

The children will be learning how to be a good listener in different situations including whole group and one to one interactions.

We will be encouraging the use of language to recreate roles and experiences in their play, providing the opportunity for children to practice listening to each other.

We will be discussing and demonstrating good practices regarding exercise, eating and sleeping as well as developing independence when managing dressing and toileting needs.
