A lot has happened on the mountain since our last Fire Flash. The Tinder Fire impacted our entire community, especially those who lost homes and/or out buildings. What I have witnessed since the fire is an outpouring of support for each other from the entire community. It is a reminder of why many of us have chosen to make this area our home. My thoughts and prayers are with those who have suffered losses and are trying to move forward with their lives.

We had a good attendance at our May meeting. We were able to get volunteers to cover the vacant areas for the sale. It was decided to have the annual appreciation dinner on Saturday, August 4th at 5:00 PM. Please mark your calendars. The Fire Fighters have requested that we do steaks and chicken again.

Chief Paine signed a contract with AmeriGas for propane thru May 2019 at \$1.59 a gallon. This price is being extended to the auxiliary. For those members who are currently AmeriGas customers, you need to do nothing. For members wishing to switch to AmeriGas, you will need to call (928-474-3334) the Payson office to set up an account. They have our 2017 membership list. They would like our 2018 membership list by mid-July, so please get your dues in by July 15th, so I can get the updated list to them. Since we are a 501C-3 organization we can participate in the AmeriGas Community Cares program. AmeriGas will donate 2 cents per every gallon of propane we buy to the auxiliary. To get credit for this you will need to turn in your original delivery ticket or the second page of your bill which says Community/School Days Receipt. I am working with Chief Paine to identify a drop box at the station for these receipts. We will need to turn them in each September for the year. We will then receive a check in October for the year.
