evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. <sup>23</sup>Let  
us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering,  
for he who has promised is faithful. <sup>24</sup>And let us consider  
how to provoke one another to love and good deeds, <sup>25</sup>not  
neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but  
encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day

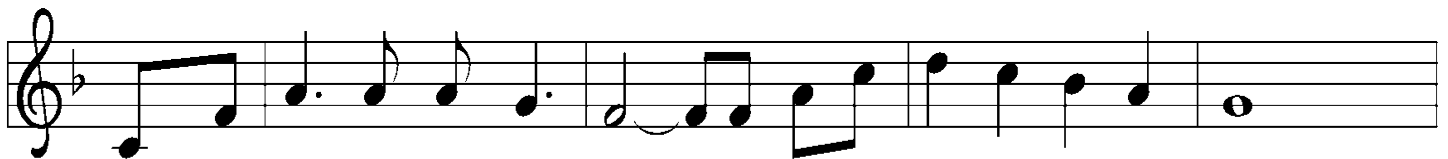

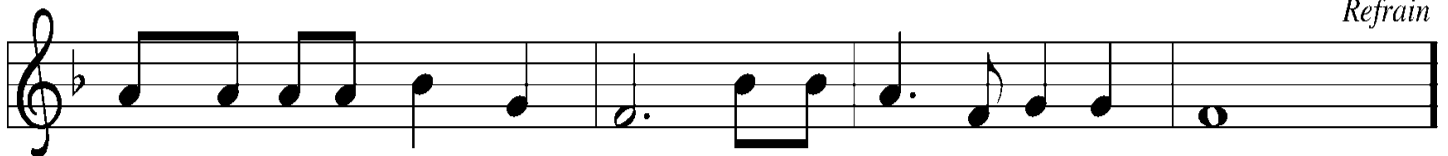


