

# WILBUR W. PARTLO

## 1924-1993

Wilbur W. Partlo, 69, longtime-elected official of Alton Village and Township, died Friday, Nov. 26, in St. Mary's Hospital, Saginaw.

Mr. Partlo was born in Whittemore on March 30, 1924. He was married to Claudine Raymond on Jan. 3, 1948, in Waver United Methodist Church.

He was a lifelong resident of Tuscola County and a veteran of World War II. He served on Alton Village Council for 25 years, was Alton Township supervisor, and served on Tuscola County Department of Public Works and Tuscola County Building Codes Council. He was a member of Fairgrove Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 7488, Caro Allied Veterans and American Legion Post, Unionville.

Surviving Mr. Partlo are his wife, Claudine, one son, Gary Partlo of Alton, daughters Debbie Meyer of Alton, Coiene Enos and husband, Michael Enos of Alton, Lynne Emers and husband, Jerry Emers of Sandusky, two grandsons and five granddaughters, and brothers and sisters-in-law, Alvin Partlo and wife, Nathalia, of North Carolina, Leslie Partlo and wife, Helen, of Bay City, Richard Partlo and wife, Charlene, of Cadillac, Keith Partlo of Alton and Mary Partlo of South Carolina, and many nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by one sister, Alotha Barry, and one brother, Bernard Partlo.

The funeral service took place at 11 a.m. Monday in Alton United Methodist Church. A Veterans Memorial Service took place at 7 p.m. Sunday in Briggs-Trenemy Funeral Home, Alton. Burial was at Fort Custer, Battle Creek.
