This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine. The life-size bronze depiction has temporarily been placed at the church in Antonito and will eventually be placed at the Santuario along with six additional mission statues. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio.

In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Santuario and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos.

We want to acknowledge the generous contributions we have received to keep the project moving along and to local santero Chris Cisneros for his contribution of a beautiful carved depiction of Our Lady of Guadalupe that is on display in the middle of the courtyard. **MASS THEME** **BIBLICAL COMMENTARY**

**Theme: Master, I Want To See**

**FIRST READING •Jer 31:7-9 [God's Deliverance]**

"I have never seen it that way," we might exclaim when a friend opens our eyes. "I did not know him/her that well," we might murmur when circumstances have shown us some beautiful facets of his/her personality that we had overlooked during years of social contact. Meeting good persons may change our lives. Such persons may open our eyes to values we have overlooked. They may broaden our way of looking at things and encourage us when we are "down in the dumps." They may show us danger where we do not see it. The miracle narratives of the Gospel tell us about deprived and unhappy people who started a new life once they had met our Lord. Have you "met" our Lord to such an extent that he fascinates you, that you are convinced that doing things his way will brighten your life? Pray that your eyes may be opened to see it! Blindness of mind may deserve blame, if it is caused by indifference and lack of care.

The setting is the long-awaited homecoming of the Israelites from their exile in Babylon. "Shout with joy for Jacob [Israel, God's people]." The author never lost trust in God that sometime or somehow he would heal the wounds of his people. The weak, lame, and blind (see Gospel!) are with the returning exiles. God cares! The fact that "God cares" is also God's word to us now. "The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy" (Responsorial Psalm).

**SECOND READING •Heb 5:1-6 [Christ the Mediator]**

The author refers again to the Jewish high priest officiating in the temple of Jerusalem. He represents human beings to God by offering gifts and sacrifices. It is stated that Jesus is the high priest of the community and as such appointed by God. Jesus exercises his priesthood in heaven. Constantly referring to his sacrificial death on the cross, he pleads for mercy for all of us.
