



Colorado Pony Of the Americas Club Scholarship



The Colorado Pony Of the Americas Club offers scholarships to qualified applicants. Applicants must be active participants in the Colorado Pony Of the Americas Club, high school seniors or high school graduates, and planning to attend a properly accredited institution of higher education. This may include technical schools, 2-year colleges, business colleges, graduate schools, etc. Applicants should demonstrate the desire to complete additional schooling or training. The total award is \$600.00 and is sent directly to the institution of higher education in two equal installments.

Although academic success may be one indicator of an applicant's ability to meet certain types of challenges, academic success shall not be the only criterion upon which the scholarship recipient will be determined. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of several criteria: active participation in Colorado Pony Of the Americas Club activities, including participation in at least 50 percent of Colorado POAC shows; the possibility of future service and participation in the Colorado Pony Of the Americas Club; character and sportsmanship; and academic interests and achievements.

Recipients are eligible to apply a second time for a scholarship. Applicants from previous years who were not awarded a scholarship are eligible to reapply if they continue to meet the application criteria.

Scholarship winners will be announced after May 1. Applicants will be notified in writing as soon as possible after May 1. Recipients must use the scholarship during the indicated school year. If an individual who has been awarded a scholarship fails to enroll in a course of higher education during that year, the award will remain with the Colorado Pony Of the Americas Club scholarship committee.

The Colorado Pony Of the Americas Club board of directors will appoint a scholarship committee to make the selection. The decision of the scholarship committee is final. No relative of any applicant may serve on the committee.

The scholarship application is attached. A letter of recommendation should be submitted with the application.

The Colorado POA Club is pleased to be able to award this scholarship. We look forward to receiving your application. We wish you good luck in your academic endeavors.

The scholarship application must be postmarked by April 15.
