Chimney Rock Congregational Council Minutes – May 10, 2022

Call to Order—The Congregational Council of Chimney Rock Church was called to order at 6:06pm on Tuesday, May 10, 2022, by Council President Forrest Nutter.

Members present—In addition to Forrest, Jon Flury, Randy Olson, Bev Paulsen, Dan Solfest, and Barb Sylla attended. Cristal Kingsbury, Brad Olson, and Pastor Paul Tobiason were absent.

Secretary's Report—Minutes of the April 12, 2022 meeting were read by Barb. Randy and Bev motioned to accept and motion carried.

Treasurer's Report—Dan distributed the financial report through April 30, 2022. Randy motioned to accept and Jon seconded the motion, which carried. Dan also distributed a financial report from the chicken dinner.

Old Business

1. **The drive-through chicken dinner** held on April 24 went very well, with 250 meals sold and net proceeds of \$3,505.46, which included monetary donations of \$1,740. Other donations that offset dinner expenses included a \$250 Thrivent card obtained by Forrest, as well as donations of additional charcoal, butter, water, beans, etc.
2. **The Synod Assembly on April 30** was attended by Pastor Tobiason and Forrest Nutter. The Synod expects ten new seminary graduates this year, 2022. Recycling (going "green") is an emphasis of the ELCA.
3. **Copyright Laws**—Forrest confirmed that, under Public Performance copyright rules, the use of pre-recorded music is perfectly okay within our worship service/setting but not if we live-stream services or share digitally. Also, the printed Bible verses in the bulletins are within copyright requirements.
4. **Louvers**—Orrin Twerberg, who had previously given \$15,000 for the louver project in memory of his parents Joel and Rebecca Twerberg, gave an additional \$16,000 to cover the entire cost. Forrest will send him a thank you.
5. **Fascia and soffit**—Asher and Stendahl declined to bid on painting the soffit and fascia. Forrest obtained a new bid of \$51,724 from Jurowski Construction, which includes replacing the louvers and tuck pointing the bell tower, painting the soffit and fascia, and use of a boom lift. Randy motioned to approve the bid and to schedule a congregational meeting after worship on May 29. The motion was seconded by Bev and carried. Letters will be emailed/mailed to members informing them of the meeting.

New Business

Eleva American Legion Post 459 Commander Rob Rasmussen inquired if Chimney Rock Church would like to have a Memorial Day program at 1pm this year. Presently, we have 67 veterans buried here whose names are read during the service at Eleva Lutheran. It was decided that the Cemetery Association should make this decision. Forrest will contact Mr. Rasmussen to inform him and also Al Barneson of the Cemetery Association.

Next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 13, at 6pm.

Adjournment—Barb and Jon motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:11pm. All joined in praying the Lord's Prayer.
