TOWN OF KREMMLING  
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING

July 3, 2019

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Grover Pryor called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Trustees present Gina Schroeder, Jason Wikberg, Leo Pesch, and Erik Woog. Staff present: Town Manager Dan Stoltman, Police Chief Jaime Lucas, and Town Clerk Joanna Eaton. Absent: Holly Martinson, Dave Sammons, and Public Works Director Jason Bock.

WOOG MOVED TO APPROVE THE REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF JUNE 5, 2019. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

WOOG MOVED TO APPROVE EXPENDITURES DATED JUNE 6 THROUGH JULY 3, 2019 FOR A TOTAL OF \$365,394.13. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

SCHROEDER MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS PRESENTED. PESCH SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

The Police Chief reported:

- Three iPads have been installed in the patrol cars; this should help increase the presence of the officers by allowing them to work more outside of the office.
- Chief Lucas had no further reports.


Public Works Director reported:


- The waterline project across the airport and the fairgrounds is complete and seems to be producing 50-100k gallons less than before the leaking steel line that used to run across the airport.
- Reservoir stopped spilling this last weekend.
- The emergency repair on the line between the water plant and the town is wrapping up and shouldn't have to worry about it for a couple years.
- Kremmling Days went very well.

Manager Report: Kremmling Days went well this year, however Manager Stoltman and Chief Lucas would like to see a new and better organized route for the parade. The Board had a few concerns with the Mosquito Control Group relating to how often they should be in Kremmling and what their plans are for the rest of the summer. Manger Stoltman stated he will be looking more into the contract and will find any answers to the questions and concerns.

**Discussion and Action on Ordinance 690, Amending Sec. 8.24.30 C (2) of the Kremmling Municipal Code** - Manager Stoltman and Chief Lucas have been concerned with the amount of non-operating vehicles throughout the town, this includes vehicles that do not run and aren't currently registered appropriately. The issue in the Ordinance they see is the section about fitted car covers. They feel as though the problem with the non-operable cars will not be solved if the town allows car covers to be used over them. No further discussion was made. PESCH SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.
