My name is Scott Sanborn and I'm your Commodore for 2023-2024. Thank You for voting for me.

I have been coming down to this club since I was 6 years old, so that's 55 years ago. I grew up at this club and have a life time of memories of our Mona Lake Boating Club. I remember spending a lot of time here but mostly remember the summers here at the club. I remember swimming, boating, spending all day at the Mona Lake Channel, learning to water ski, fishing with my Grandpa, family funday and the kids events they had for us, Fourth of July fireworks, Adult egg tosses, cooking on the permanent charcoal grills that set just off the beach and smelling the polish sausage cooking. If you know me we had shirts made up that say "Polish Sausage Mafia" that is where that came from, my memories "I have many stories to tell just ask". I remember the beer tents where cars and boat were all over the beach and gas dock and cars were all the way down to Ross Park and to Henry St. I have a lifetime of good memories of our club. My father was the Commodore in 1969-1970. Our children are even members of our club. Three generation strong! I love "This Club - My Club - Our Club"

My mission and goal will be to improve our volunteerism. We need help in this area and I'm asking you to help our Mona Lake Boating Club. We have a very strong membership and a lot of very good people, but struggle in getting some of our members to volunteer for our lunches on Wednesday and Friday and Variety Dinners on Friday nights. On Variety dinner night we sometimes need two volunteers to work the door and take orders, make salads, work the fryer, serve our special for the night and do dishes. Now we don't always need to fill every position. But sometimes we may need a couple positions to be filled. These are weekly positions that may need to be filled each week. Some of these positions will need some training and some are self explanatory.

We also struggle in our volunteerism in our Annual and Special Events. New Year's Eve and Kid's Christmas Party are examples of Annual events and Weddings, Life Celebrations are examples of Special Events. We may have a dozen or more of these events per year that in the past has exhausted our few volunteers because there may only be a small number of volunteers that HAVE to do them all or it has been up to our Manager to do it all and that's not fair and is also exhausting for her and them. Our Boat Club needs help putting up and taking down decorations. We need help with setting up and taking down for events, setting tables, clear dishes off tables which includes doing all dishes and putting them away. Preparing food, veggie trays, meat trays, sandwiches etc. for these party's when our kitchen staff is not available or just needs some extra hands. It is no different preparing for a party in your own home. It's a lot of work! Some of these positions will need some training and some are self explanatory.

So please if you have not volunteered VOLUNTEER. If you are not able to volunteer contact a member that can and ask them to volunteer for you. Our volunteer committee will be working on a new system. We have a system in place now its call Sign Up Genius, but I have to admit I'm not a good computer person. I feel we may need 20 or more volunteers to get us thru the New Year. There is a calendar in the club next to the billboard in bar area that is used to pencil your name in to help. Feel free to call the club and leave a message and I or someone on committee will contact you.

If you contacted just your family and friends in your inner circle that are members of our Boat Club and ask them to volunteer with you, we may never have to ask for volunteers again. Just maybe....

A Banquet date will be announced soon. A special youth prize will be available & awarded at the banquet. Adult hunters will be judged on legal points & Director will be decided by largest antler spread. Safe hunting!
