

Targeted Case Managers can:

Assist participants with identifying and accessing available services and supports needed to maintain good mental and physical health.

Advocate for youth in the schools by attending meetings and linking them to educational resources to promote success.

Assist participants with forming healthy relationships, developing natural and community supports, increasing social involvement and achieving personal goals.

Assist participants with obtaining and maintaining safe, affordable housing by linking them to rental agencies, emergency and transitional housing programs, subsidized housing resources, and assisted living facilities.

Assist participants with obtaining employment by helping them access training and resources to increase employability skills, and providing information on job fairs and hiring employers.

Assist participants with accessing basic needs such as food and clothing.
