Remember your Keytags!

Our updated check-in systems using the keytags was very successful last year. If you have your keytags from last year, you will use them for entry and exiting the pool again this year.

If you are a new member or a member who has not yet picked up your keytags, please ask to speak with a manager when you go to the pool. The manager on duty will get your picture into our check-in database, explain the keytag process, and have you sign for your keytags. Each member on your membership has been assigned a keytag (yes, even the babies) and needs a picture in our system.

There is no cost for the initial keytag. Replacement keytags are \$1 each. Ask the guard at the front desk for a Replacement Keytag form to order replacement keytags

Note: Any keytag that was NOT renewed this year has been removed from the check-in system and cannot be used for entry into the pool.

Come join the swim and dive team! The Hayfield Farm Swim and Dive Teams are ready to begin another great season of fun, fast swimming and sportsmanship! The swimmers and divers who proudly call themselves the “Hayfield Seahawks” compete in the Northern Virginia Swim League (NVSL) with other swim and dive teams in the surrounding communities and across Northern VA.

Both the swim and dive teams had fun, competitive seasons in 2014. This season, the swim team has moved to Division 12. The dive team is in competitive Division 3. One of the highlights of the 2014 season for both teams was participation in a swim-a-thon fundraiser, where the team raised over \$6,000 for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society!

All Hayfield pool members are welcome to join the swim or dive teams, there is also a learn-to-swim program called Mini Hawks for swimmers who are not quite ready for the competitive team. To register for Mini Hawks, swimmers must be four years old as of June 1, 2015.

Members need to come to the pool IN PERSON to fill out/turn in a Pool Party Guest List Form to sign up for the party reservation. In the event of a "no show," the deposit will not be returned. We receive multiple requests for same day/same time and we have occasional no shows. Lifeguards are scheduled based on the anticipated number of guests during the day and additional staff may be required for your party's confirmed number".

OTHER FEES

Guest Fees: Age 3 and under are free, Ages 4 and above are \$5.00. There is no distinction between a swimming and non- swimming guest.

Houseguest: A 1-week pass is \$10/person; \$25/family or a 1-month pass is \$25/person, \$50/family.

Caregiver/Nanny Pass: (Non-pool-member who cares for member's children) A summer caregiver pass is \$25. The caregiver's own children are \$25/child. Caregiver may not bring a non-member child who is not a member of the immediate family; caregiver may not visit pool without member's child.

Child-care Provider: (pool member who provides child care for non-member children) for a 1-month pass pays \$20/child, or \$50/child for the summer.

ATTENTION DOG WALKERS

Please be sure to clean up after your pet, especially on the lawn in front of the pool and the area at the end of Hayfield Road behind the barricade.

If you know of individuals who walk down by the pool, please let them know to help us out. **IT IS A COUNTY LAW TO CLEAN UP!**
