SAFETY ORTS:

Remember the 3 Rules of Gun Safety:

ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction

ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot

ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use

Most gun accidents are caused by ignorance and/or carelessness.

It is our constitutional right to own and use a firearm. With this right come responsibilities. We should:

Store, operate and maintain our firearms safely

Ensure unauthorized or untrained individuals can't get to our firearms

Learn and obey all laws pertaining to purchase, possession and use of firearms

This may seem rote to you / us but it is always good to get reminders. It is very easy to become complacent and lose focus which can lead to carelessness and an accident. Just because many of us have used firearms for many years doesn't give us the right to lose focus and become careless.

Safety is of the utmost importance. The damage to the range needs to stop before someone gets hurt. If a member doesn't attend one of the range rule refresher trainings set up in "late" 2018 they will not be allowed to renew membership for 2019 until they attend the refresher training.
