

Symbols of the Holy Spirit (cont.)

When he proclaims and promises the coming of the Holy Spirit, Jesus calls him the "Paraclete," literally, "he who is called to ones side," *ad-vocatus*. "Paraclete" is commonly translated as "consoler," and Jesus is the first consoler. The Lord also called the Holy Spirit "the Spirit of Truth."

Besides the proper name of "Holy Spirit," which is most frequently used in the *Acts of the Apostles* and in the Epistles, we also find in St. Paul the Titles: The Spirit of the promise, the Spirit of adoption, the Spirit of Christ, the Spirit of the Lord, and the Spirit of God--and, in St. Peter, the Spirit of glory.

In addition to titles of the Holy Spirit that we find there, there are numerous symbols of the Holy Spirit that we encounter as well which are:

Fire: While water signifies birth and the fruitfulness of the life given in the Holy Spirit, fire symbolized the transforming energy of the Holy Spirit's actions. The prayer of the prophet Elijah, who "arose like fire" and whose "word burned like a torch," brought down fire from heaven on the sacrifice on Mount Carmel. This event was a "figure" of the fire of the Holy Spirit, who transforms what he touches. John the Baptist, who goes, "before [the Lord] in the spirit and power of Elijah," proclaims Christ as the one who "will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire." Jesus will say of the Spirit: "I came to cast fire upon the earth; and would that it were already kindled!" In the form of tongues "as of fire," the Holy Spirit rests on the disciples on the morning of Pentecost and fills them with himself. The spiritual tradition has retained this symbolism of fire as one of the most expressive images of the Holy Spirit's actions. "Do not quench the Spirit." (to be continued...)

THE VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY Feast Day May 31

"The theme of the Feast of the Visitation centers on Mary responding to the prompting of the Holy Spirit to set out on a mission of charity." The Visitation is not just a story of a casual visit between two

cousins--but rather a story of how God interacts in our lives in often subtle and unseen ways whose results can have untold results. The Visitation gives us an opportunity to discern how God is present in our lives, what he may be saying to us--angel or not--and how we respond to that message in light of his divine plan for us personally and for all humanity. We know that Gabriel had informed Mary of both the birth of Jesus and John the Baptist Elizabeth's child. Mary shortly afterwards made a trip of possibly 80+ miles from Nazareth to Ein Karem south of Jerusalem--a long ways then. She is not motivated by curiosity, nor does she make the journey to discover for herself whether the angel's message is true. Humble, filled with charity--a charity that leads her to be more concerned for her elderly cousin than for herself. Through her presence and the presence of the Divine Child in her womb Mary exercised her function as mediatrix between God and man for the first time. It is held that the purpose of the Visitation was to bring divine grace through the Holy Spirit to Elizabeth and her unborn child who would be the forerunner of Jesus.
