From the Pastoral Associate: First, Happy Mother's Day to all the moms in our parish. May this day be a blessed one for you and your family. May you all have a great gift next week. Next week is Pentecost. The Father gives us the great gift of the Holy Spirit and through it we have the Sacraments. I sometimes feel as if we as Christians do not appreciate the gift of the Holy Spirit enough. What would happen if every day this week we all prayed, really hard for the Holy Spirit to pour down on each and every member gathered at Mass and all our family members wherever they are gathered. What might happen? What would happen if 20% of us received the gift of healing so we can heal in Jesus' name. What if 20% of us received the gift on tongues and started babbling joyful praise at Mass and uncontrollable joy in all of our daily prayers to the Father? What if 20% of us became so much more loving we forgave everyone and gave all our possessions away, for we felt called to a life of poverty. Of course, this would mean that our lives would radically change, which is one reason I suspect we don't desperately plea to the Father to fill us more with the Holy Spirit. Deep down we really do not want to change. We are content to keep our lives the same, rather than to grow deeper in our walk with God. Let us be daring this week! Let us beg the Father in the name of Jesus for more gifts of the Holy Spirit. Let us pray this week, "In the name of Jesus, Father please pour out upon me and Your family You have given me and Your parish that I am a part of with many gifts of the Holy Spirit this Pentecost, so that we may be changed into better disciples on fire to do Your will. Amen" If we do this the people of Morrison County who are not Christian may all become Christian in 10 years because of the movement of the Holy Spirit in us. This is the mission of the church.
