REGULAR MEETING

NOVEMBER 4, 2015 6:00 PM

1. Meeting called to order by Chairman Robert Long with the following members present: Dwight Gordon, Gerald Blocker and Willie Frank Thompson.
2. Meeting led in prayer by Mr. Chapman.
3. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to accept minutes. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
4. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Gordon and carried to accept Pine Tar Road as a County maintained road. This road was approved by Wilford Morris, Road Department Supervisor. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Thompson voted yea.
5. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Gordon and carried to accept the resolution for the Georgia Recreation Trail Program through the Georgia Department of Natural Resources for a walking trail at the Long County Recreation Park. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Thompson voted yea.
6. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to accept the RFP from for the FY 2013-2014 in the amount of \$24,250.00 plus mileage. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
7. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Gordon and carried to accept Jeff White's bid for the concrete behind the courthouse where a storage building will be erected in the amount of \$1,275.00. We received three bids. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Thompson voted yea.
8. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to change our meeting date from December 2, 2014 to December 9, 2014 due to training for the commissioners. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.

9. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to purchase a New Holland Tractor for the Road Department out of the SPLOST account in the amount of \$49,600.00. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
10. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried hereby to agree to send the updated Long County and Ludowici Comprehensive Plan to the DCA for review and approval. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
11. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Gordon and carried to accept the Stillwood Subdivision, which are 4 lots in Long County, developed in 1989. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Thompson voted yea.
12. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to table the appointment for the Long County Development Authority Board to a later date. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
13. Motion made by Mr. Gordon, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to table the adopting of the Long County Fire Department Policy and Procedures to the next meeting. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Blocker voted yea.
14. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to hire Jessica Holten for the part-time position in the Long County Commissioners Office. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
15. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Gordon and carried to fund the Trail 37/301 Project in the amount of \$500.00. The Long County Chamber of Commerce is over this project with Chamber of Commerce in adjoining counties along Highway 301. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Blocker voted yea.
16. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to enter executive session for personnel, potential litigation and land acquisition. Mr. Long voted yea and Gordon voted yea.
17. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to exit executive session. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
18. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to pay bills. Mr. Long voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.

4. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to notify Bill Nutting and Randy Klingensmith that the board stands by the roads in Vickers Hill is not county roads.
5. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried we will not accept roads in Vickers Hill Subdivision.
6. Motion made by Mr. Gordon, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to appoint Richard Truman temporarily as EMS Director for Long County. The supplement is \$3,600.00.
