January 29th will be our Annual Meeting. We will meet at 8:30 for an abbreviated worship and move directly into the Annual Meeting. For those who would like to attend through Zoom you will be able to begin to log into the Zoom link at 8:45 am. The Council members will then take your names down to add you to our quorum total for the meeting.

Participation in our meeting can take place in 3 ways: in-person at the church; using your computer, pad, tablet or smart phone to log in to Zoom; or call in using your phone.

Business items for the agenda will include general elections, consideration of entering into a parish agreement with Concordia Lutheran Church of Pickerel Lake, and consideration of the proposed 2023 Budget. A vote to approve the parish agreement requires a 2/3 majority vote by both congregations in the parish agreement. A written ballot is not required for this agreement. A quorum for the meeting is 50 active voting members.

Immediately following the Annual Meeting, a separate special congregational meeting has been called by the Church Council for Sunday, January 29<sup>th</sup>. The single purpose of this special meeting is to consider the approval of the call of Rev. Kristi Mitchell as pastor for the Concordia Pickerel Lake/Redeemer Lutheran Parish (contingent on the approval of the Parish Agreement by both congregations.) Redeemer Lutheran Church will extend the call to Rev. Kristi Mitchell for Redeemer Lutheran Church and on behalf of Concordia Lutheran Church of Pickerel Lake. Concordia Lutheran Church will be required to approve this call on their behalf at a special congregational meeting for their congregation.

According to our constitution, the vote to call a pastor requires a 2/3 majority vote of the active members present. The vote must be a written ballot. A quorum for the meeting is 50 active voting members.

A detailed letter will be sent to all congregation members after the first of the year which will include greater detailed instructions for the Zoom option for the meeting. 
# Camp Day Sunday, January 22nd
