Grace & Peace from the Pastor's Desk

What is your life verse? Do you have one? Or are you more like me, there are several that keep you going throughout good times and bad? I took that Facebook quiz once and it gave me one that is suitable and easy to remember... Hebrews 10:23 "Let us hold fast go the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful." Our hope comes through Jesus Christ who lived, died, and was resurrected so that we know there is more to life than what we experience here on earth. God's promises are faithful and sure.

Which leads to one of my life verses I found on my own and have discovered that many people cling to this verse: Jeremiah 29:11 "For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope." There were times in my life that I really struggled to know that what I was going through was worth the outcome, and this promise carried me through those struggles.

Another verse that I have called upon I learned at Vacation Bible School (as an adult teacher). Colossians 3:23 "Whatever your task, put yourselves into it, as done for the Lord and not for your masters" that's the NRSV translation... I'm not sure what translation I learned because it was in a song, but it was basically "whatever you do, do it for the Lord not for man." I learned from this verse that everything that I do is to glorify God and my life is about pleasing God, not people.

Yet in Ephesians 4:1-3 the apostle Paul reminds us that the relationships we have with the people here on earth are important when he says: "I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" "The unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" is far different than simply keeping the peace, it is remembering God's love for everyone is what guides our words and actions, acting out of humility and gentleness with patience... it's difficult to remember this sometimes!

News from your Church Council



In recent months, the Church Council agreed to apply for monies from the Payroll Protection Program which was offered to small businesses during the COVID-19 Pandemic. The application for the loan was submitted and Immanuel was approved and received \$10,102 to help with expenses for payroll and utility costs during 2021. At a further date an application will be submitted to ask for the loan to be forgiven.

This past January, Michael Redditt was asked to install a new computer and upgrade software to improve office functions. At that time, he recommended the church should increase our internet speed, expand our WiFi network, and include a guest network for access for members and groups. In February, the Church Council approved the decision to upgrade our internet services to provide a faster internet for future live streaming capabilities. Immanuel applied for a technology grant from the Northwest PA Synod and Immanuel was awarded \$500 to cover the costs of the equipment to implement the new mesh network and update our router. Also, by changing internet service providers we not only incurred a faster internet speed, but lowered our monthly internet and phone costs by nearly 50%.

The Church Council would like to extend a huge thank you to Michael Redditt for coordinating our technology needs, installing the new office computer and installing and implementing the new WiFi mesh network.
