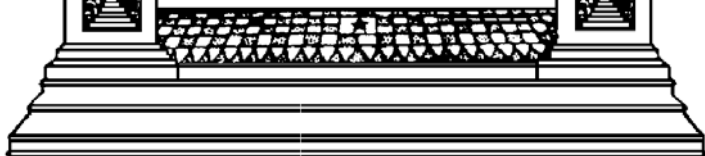

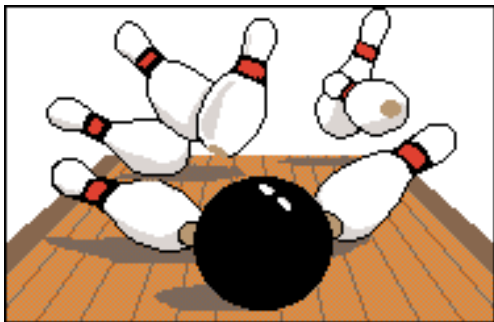


FIFTY YEAR PIN NIGHT
