The Wisdom of Jesus

The skeptic is an odd individual, indeed. The same rhetoric is consistently used by the majority, i.e., “The Bible contradicts itself;” “The Bible was written by men in an endeavor to control the masses.” As Solomon said, “That which has been is that which will be, And that which has been done is that which will be done. So there is nothing new under the sun” (Eccl. 1:9). This is also true of the skeptic.

The skeptic likes to use the “shotgun” approach to a Biblical discussion: like buckshot out of a barrel, they attempt to stir up smoke as they fire, what they believe to be, unanswerable questions. That is what the Pharisees and the Herodians attempted: “And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, that they might catch him in talk. - A. Deut. 10:13 – The statutes of Jehovah were given for the good of the people.
 - 1. Eph. 6:1-2 – For each person severally.
 - 2. Exod. 20:16 – For all others
- B. Heb. 6:4-8 – Those who fall away.
 - 1. Matt. 27:3 – Death of the one
 - 2. Vs. 5 – ruin and death of the other
- C. Eph. 4:31-32 – When you encourage individuals to respond to the will of God, it is for the well-being of all.
