**Parish Ministry and Leadership Conference: "Living a Eucharistic Life as Missionary Disciples"**



## St. Pius of Pietrelcina | September 23



**ST. PADRE PIO**

FEAST DAY  
**SEPTEMBER 23**

Best known as Padre Pio, St. Pius was born Francesco Forgione in 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy. As a young boy he suffered many illnesses. He joined Capuchin Franciscans at 15 and took the name of Pius or "Pio" in honor of Pope Pius I. He was ordained in 1910, and at this time he received the marks of stigmata, the wounds of Christ, eventually healing.

Padre Pio served in the Italian Medical Corps during WW I, but he was discharged because of illness, likely tb. He was assigned to the friary in San Giovanni Rotondo. In 1918, while continuing to serve at the friary, the stigmata appeared again, and remained until his death.

Many faithful came to see him, his days were long, beginning with Mass at 5 a.m. then hearing confessions all day with breaks to bless the sick. A simple man, content to do God's will on earth and with the ardent desire to serve the sick and poor in whom he saw Christ. Padre Pio died at the age of eighty-one in 1968 and in 2002 he was Canonized by Pope John Paul II.


