

Allan Cruse is a 1959 graduate of Indian Springs School and a 1962 alumnus of Emory University. He co-authored an introductory textbook on calculus at the University of San Francisco before returning to Emory to complete his mathematics Ph.D. in 1974. As a faculty member at USF his research into large combinatorial designs led him to investigate computer systems programming and to create an online archive of classroom slides and demos that seems now to have been copied in various countries. Upon retiring from his teaching career at USF in 2009, Allan soon was introduced to Romania through the Indian Springs Alumni and Chamber Choir Tour in June 2011.
