Once in Monteverde, you'll take an exceptional hike where you'll experience different species of birds, rich beds of moss, flowers, lichen, and bromeliads. Visit a frog pond or the serpentarium to see some of the wildlife in the area and complete the journey to the famous cloud forest. After the hike, lunch will be served before you head back to your hotel.
