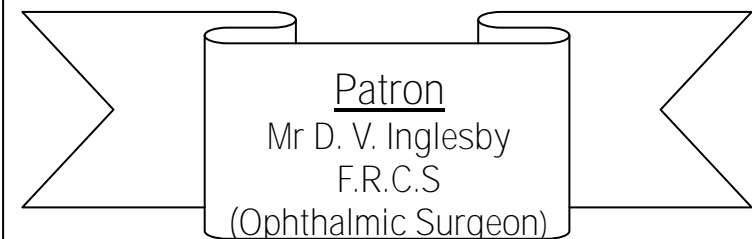
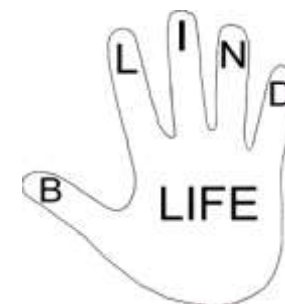

What do we do?

- * We are a friendly pro-active group of blind and partially sighted people. We meet on a regular basis for social and sport activities.

What's involved in audio recording and editing?

Do you have a reasonable / clear speaking voice?

Audio editing

Some computer skills needed though specific training will be given.

What about a Criminal Record Board Certificate?

Yes you will need one. We will provide and pay for this.

Where do I work?

You will work in a sound studio at Crook. Refreshments will be provided and you can take breaks as you need them. There is also free off street parking.

What about training?

We will give advice and training on producing clear correctly paced recordings to benefit visually impaired people. Editing skills for digital computer produced items will also be developed.

What about references?

You will need a character reference.

What do you do with the information you have about me?

This will be held securely. We will keep information that is relevant to your role as volunteer under the terms of the Data Protection Act.
