

CLARE ADAM SCHEURER, M.D.

1906 - 1977

Dr. C.A. Scheurer, age 71 of Pigeon, passed away Wednesday, October 12, at St. Luke's Hospital, Saginaw.

He was born August 12, 1906, in Sebewaing. On October 14, 1937, he was united in marriage to Clara L. Peter.

He was a member of Winsor Lodge 420 F. & A.M., and a charter member of the Pigeon Rotary Club, which presented him with the esteemed Community Service award from Rotary International. He was also affiliated with the Huron County Medical Society and the Michigan State Medical Society, American Medical Society, Academy of General Practitioners. Dr. Scheurer was instrumental in the formation of the Laker School District, where he was a member of the Board of Education for 25 years; in the development of Sand Point into one of the great resort sections of lower Michigan, and development of two subdivisions in Pigeon. In 1940 he built a medical clinic in Pigeon and in 1945 added a section which became Scheurer Hospital.

Dr. Scheurer is survived by his wife, Clara; three daughters, Mrs. John (Mary Louise) Rummel of Frankenmuth, Mrs. James (Margaret) McBride, and Mrs. Curtis (Maurine) Roth, Pigeon; one son, Clare Adam Scheurer, M.D., Walled Lake; and nine grandchildren. One son, John Wesley and one sister, Ethel, preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, October 15 at 10 a.m. from the Shetler-Bussema Funeral Home, Pigeon. Rev. Terry Claus of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Caseville, will officiate with burial in Memorial Park Cemetery, Sebewaing.
