Dear Residents,

#### **VESPERS**

On Monday, November 18, Dr. Rolf Myhrman, recently retired science professor at Judson University, will be our speaker. Rolf struggled for a time in young adulthood as to the weather God was calling him into full time Christian ministry or in into a career in the field of science. He earned a B.S. in Preengineering from Columbia University in N.Y.C. and a PhD. in Chemistry from Northwestern University in Evanston. After a postdoctoral research at Rush University in Chicago, Rolf joined the faculty of Judson University. At Judson he combined his love for ministry and his love for science. During Rolf's forty-one years at Judson he made a myriad valuable contribution. To name a few he taught chemistry and biochemistry, served as chapel coordinators and conducted a researched program with his students on the use of the velvet bean as a valuable food source for undernourished people in India, Central America and Africa.
