Winter is upon us, and we recently experienced our first snowfalls of the year. With these significant storms, we'd like to offer a few reminders. The first is to please be patient in heavy snow events. Our Service Department plows and salts main streets, such as Rt. 84, Rt. 91 and Euclid Avenue first, followed by police and fire stations, public parking lots, and finally side roads and cul de sacs. Also, when snowfall exceeds two inches, we may issue a parking ban. The parking ban allows our plows to work safely, efficiently, and without obstructions. We will post a notice of a parking ban on the Police Department and the City Facebook pages during a significant snowstorm. Also, there may be trash collection delays due to weather, and Republic Services will also post on social media when this happens. You can also sign up for notifications of snow delays on the Republic Service

Need a place to hold that picnic, party or family event? - Why not use a Willoughby park pavilion? Another helpful resource is our Emergency Management Agency. Lake County encourages our residents to sign up for their reverse 911 system. The system allows the county Emergency Management Agency to communicate with our residents in flood events, extreme weather conditions, and other emergencies. more than three million Americans retired early due in part to the Covid-19 pandemic. Early retirement, especially if it was not planned can present a myriad of financial issues with health insurance being a major one


