

# Wilma A. Elenbaum

## 1909 - 1997

Wilma A. Elenbaum, age 88 of Sebewaing, passed away Saturday, November 15, at Sunny Acres Nursing Center near Bad Axe.

She was born in Fair Haven Township on April 9, 1909, the daughter of the late William and Clara (Dietzel) Terrill. Over 69 years ago, on June 28, 1928 at the family farm, she was united in marriage to Merrill Elenbaum. He survives her.
