Did you know...three years of conflict have pushed Yemen, already one of the world's poorest countries, to the brink of catastrophe? CAFOD is working in conflict affected communities providing nutrition services; which involves screening and identifying children under 5 and breastfeeding mothers for acute malnutrition. We're also training community volunteers to spot the worst cases of malnutrition in their communities and get mothers and babies treated at available health facilities or in the home. Against a challenging environment, we've been able to check thousands of children suffering from malnutrition or showing signs of the condition - providing the nutritious food supplements needed for proper treatment.
