

## **General Rifle Range Rules - continued**

- Once on the firing line, a firearms muzzle must be pointed down range at all times.
- Loaded firearms must be pointed down range with barrel horizontal.
- The RSO is responsible for closely monitoring firing by shooters being particularly aware of bullet impact and the hazard possibility of unnecessary ricochets.
- If there is a misfire be sure to keep the muzzle down range (preferably on a target) for at least 30 seconds in case it is a hang fire.
- After a misfire or jam, the firearm must be cleared. If it cannot be safely cleared, the firearm must be removed from the range property as quickly and safely as possible.
- Smoking is not allowed near the benches where muzzleloaders are being used.
- The RSO may require all shooters to step behind the yellow line to ensure that the line is completely safe before declaring a cease fire.

## **Parking**

Parking is limited, especially during full range utilization. Striped parking spaces are available for general parking. If a member, or guest of member, has need for a particular parking space out of need due to disability, the RSO should help to accommodate them by asking that the parking space be freed-up.
