Darl H. Deming, age 78, of Elkton, died Tuesday evening, March 30, 2010 at the Huron County Medical Care Facility surrounded by his family.

He was born Sept. 6, 1932 in Fairhaven Township, at the home of his parents the late Albert and Stella (Beadle) Deming.
