

# Miller County Fair “Little Royalty Contest”

The event is open to all children in Miller County and adjoining counties, between the ages of four and seven, as of Sunday, July 22.

Prince and Princess candidates must be no younger than age four and no older than age five.

Little Mister and Miss candidates must be no younger than age six and no older than age seven.

There is no limit to the

number of contestants and all children meeting the requirements are welcome to participate. However, no telephone entries will be accepted.

All entry forms must be completed and postmarked or received via email, no later than Friday, July 13.

Children are encouraged to ride in Miller County Fair Parade Tuesday evening, July 24 at 6:15 p.m.

Parents need to have their children at the Miller County Fairgrounds Wednesday, July 25 at 6:15 p.m. All parents are to leave the stage area. The pageant will begin at 6:30 p.m.
