Happy New Year again from Giles County Public Library! I feel like I was just writing this article a couple of months ago for January 2023. And now it's January 2024! Is that a sign of getting old? I am not sure, but it does seem like time goes so fast. We all need to take a breath and enjoy each day we have with our family and friends and make 2024 the best it can be.

Here are some of the upcoming programs at Giles County Public Library.

On January 22 at 5:30 pm we will have an **Author Event** with **Warren Gill**. Mr. Gill is originally from Petersburg, TN in Lincoln County and currently resides there. His first book titled *Cane Creek Days* was published by FriesenPress in 2021 and his second book is the first in a series titled *Princess of Horses*. Warren Gill is Professor Emeritus from the University of Tennessee and is a retired Dept. Chair from Middle Tennessee State University. He will talk about his books and also the revitalization of the town of Petersburg.

The **Giles County Public Library** and the **Giles County Historical Society** will have a joint program for **Black History Month** on February 6 at 5:30 pm here at the library, with **Mr. John Nelson** as our speaker. Mr. Nelson will be talking about the history of schools in Giles County with a particular interest on the history of the black schools in the county. Mr. Nelson has done much research on the schools and is willing to share his knowledge with us for this program.

February will also bring a partnership with TCAT Pulaski with a **3-D printing program**. Stay tuned for more information about this exciting news!

Tamera Moody and **Clarence Plank** are aspiring children's authors. On March 4, from 5:30-6:30 pm, they will both be here to talk with us about their books.

The month of March will bring our **Quilt Show** again! Get ready to bring your quilts for display at the library. It is a beautiful sight to see the artistic and colorful quilts on the book stacks for the whole month.

As Spring comes on, we will have a program on April 2 from 5:30-6:30 pm to talk about a **Seed Library** that we will be starting. Kelly Hamlin will be here to share knowledge about seed libraries and how you can participate.

All of our normal programming will resume in January. **Ask a Librarian** happens on Wednesdays from 9:00 am-12:00 pm by appointment. So if you have something you need help with on your computer, phone or other device, call and make an appointment with one of our tech savvy librarians to get a little help.

Story Time is still on Fridays at 10:00 am in the children's room. Miss Elizabeth and Miss T'Kayah do a wonderful job every Friday morning reading, singing and crafting with a large group of pre-school children and their parents and grandparents. If you have not taken advantage of this opportunity for your little ones, you should. It is a great way to get your kids active and learn to love listening to stories and love reading!

Teenagers can participate in our **Dungeons and Dragons** program on Mondays from 2:30-5:00 pm. This is a growing program and if you have a sense of adventure and want to improve your strategic thinking and problem solving skills or make some new social connections, you are welcome to come and join our group. Miss Elizabeth serves as the Dungeon Master and she does a great job with the storytelling.

Lego Club is still meeting on the second and fourth Thursdays from 3:30- 4:30 pm for all ages.

Art in Action, a partnership with the Giles Arts Council, is meeting on the first and fourth Wednesdays for kids and adults starting in January. Patricia Hickman, retired art teacher, is leading these art classes. The adult classes are from 2:00-3:00 pm and the kid classes (ages 7-18) are from 3:30-4:30 pm. We ask that you please call and sign up for these classes.

Our **Lynnville Branch** also has an **art class** on the second Wednesday of each month and a **Lego Club** on the fourth Wednesday of each month. Both of these are at 10:30 am for all ages.

Watercolor classes are offered on the second Tuesday of each month from 5:30-6:30 pm with Caroline Bonner leading those classes. Caroline is a recent MTSU graduate in visual arts and she does a great job teaching watercolor. We ask that you call and sign up for these classes also.

Our **Kids Art Club** is offered on the second Wednesday of each month for ages 6-12 from 3:30-4:30 pm and the **STEAM Teens** stem programming is offered on the third Wednesday of each month for ages 9-16 from 3:30-4:30 pm.

We hope to see you at the library using all the wonderful resources we have or at some of the programs listed in our newsletter.






