RECOMMENDED

- ★ **Seeley Lake Campground** Enjoy lake activities plus nearby activities such as the Seth Diamond Interpretative trail. From Highway 83 in Seeley Lake take Boy Scout Road 3.5 miles.
- ★ **Big Larch Campground** Big Larch is open year round. In the spring you are likely to see river otters in the lake. Don’t miss the nature trail! Big Larch Campground is conveniently located one mile north of Seeley Lake.
- ★ **River Point Campground** Beach, swimming, horseshoe pits, volleyball and great walks/runs await your stay at River Point. Don’t forget your fishing gear! From Seeley Lake take Boy Scout road 2.5 miles to River Point Campground.
- ★ **Salmon Lake State Park** Nestled between the majestic Mission and Swan Mountain Ranges, Salmon Lake provides a beautiful and tranquil setting to enjoy boating, fishing, swimming and wildlife viewing. Salmon Lake State Park is 5 miles south of Seeley Lake on Highway 83. 16 of the 24 campsites have electricity.
