



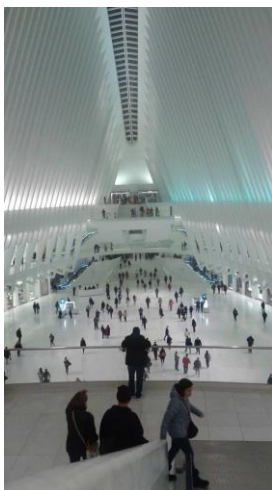
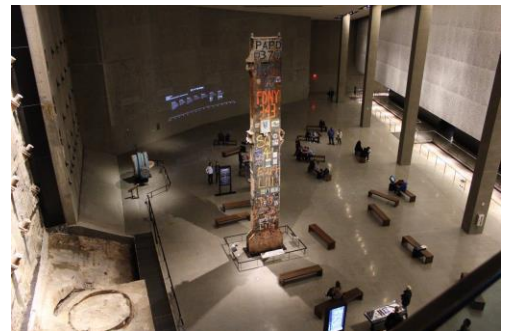
“9/11 Memorial & Museum”: The whole afternoon is devoted to visiting the 9/11 Memorial (opened in 2011) and the 9/11 Museum (opened in 2014) that are located at “Ground Zero”, the World Trade Center site. The 9/11 Memorial



honors the people lost in the terrorist attacks of 9/11/2001 as well as those lost in the bombing on 2/26/1993. At this tribute and place of remembrance, their names are inscribed in bronze surrounding the two acre-sized



reflecting pools located in the footprints of the twin towers. The 9/11 Museum tells



the story of the events of 9/11 through artifacts that range in scale from the monumental to the intimate, as well as through first-person accounts and multimedia displays. While you're at the Memorial, a stop in the World Trade Center Transportation Hub (opened in 2016) and mall
