



Rodney Goldenberg Scholarships

Background:

Rodney Goldenberg's dream of building a magnet high school in the Vista Unified School District began in 2007. In 2009, Mr. Goldenberg's dream became a reality as Mission Vista High School opened its doors on the campus of Washington Middle School. One year later, in 2010, MVHS welcomed students to its beautiful, new 6 acre campus in northeastern Oceanside where Mr. Goldenberg served as its first principal. Mr. Goldenberg's tireless effort, passion and vision were integral in creating this remarkable and leading edge campus. Mission Vista High School is a school of choice for students in the Vista Unified School District as well as surrounding communities. The 4x4 block schedule and four focus areas of Arts, Communication, Science and Technology make this school a unique option for students in North San Diego County.

The Rodney Goldenberg Scholarships:

The Mission Vista High School Timberwolves Foundation is pleased to offer three (3) scholarships in honor of Rodney Goldenberg. These scholarships align with the Mission Vista High School focus areas of Arts, Communication, Science and Technology. Each scholarship is in the amount of \$500. These are one-time awards and cannot be renewed. Scholarships will be presented at the annual Senior Awards Night. The Timberwolves Foundation will pay scholarship funds directly to the recipient's post-secondary school. The Rodney Goldenberg Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, religion, gender or sexual orientation. The Rodney Goldenberg Scholarships will be administered by the MVHS Timberwolves Foundation.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicants must have demonstrated skill and / or experience in the focus area (Arts, Communication, Science or Technology).
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college, university, or trade school program for the upcoming academic year.
- Applicants must have an intention to pursue the focus area in their future collegiate and professional life.
- Applicants must be a US citizen or permanent resident alien.

Application Process:

To apply, students must submit the following on or before April 1, 2019 **at 3:00 pm**.

- Completed scholarship application form.
- One academic reference letter or letter from teacher in focus area department.
- One personal reference letter.
- Official transcript.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies
- Personal essay 1. Please address one of the following questions in a 300 word essay:
 - Evaluate a significant experience or achievement in your chosen focus area and its impact on you.
 - Describe an idea that matters to you, a person who has influenced you, or an experience that has helped to shape your interest in your chosen focus area.
 - What effect has your experience and study in your chosen focus area had on your intellectual or personal growth?
- Personal essay 2. Please address the following questions in a 150 word essay:
 - Describe your future plans, both academic and professional.

Scholarship Awards:

- Award notification will be given at the annual Senior Awards Night.
- For fund disbursement, applicant must provide their student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be received.
