  - o Ammonia- Nitrogen now has limits in the summer and will be reported in the winter- once per week
  - o An annual reporting requirement for E. Coli
  - o Effluent limits for Aluminum, iron and manganese- twice per year
  - o CMSA is well within the requirements of the new NPDES Permit
- Meters- the meters available and the cost.
