Robert Gruenenfelder **(1922 -)** **Inducted in 1990**

A cornetist who was born and raised in New Ulm and is a music director, professional musician, musical arranger and director in the Twin Cities area. He has played with Doc Evans, Harry Blons, the Barbary Coast Banjo Brass, Como Park Summer Pops Orchestra, Lake Harriet Concert Band and the U. S. Marine Band. In August of 1990, Gruenenfelder performed with the Barbary Coast Dixieland Band at the Nagasaki Exposition in Japan. His credits as a musical director include the Jimmy Durante show, Brothers and Sisters, and the Evans and Whoopee John Band. His grandfather, Boniface was inducted into the Minnesota Music Hall of Fame in 1989.
