Dear incoming 5th grader,

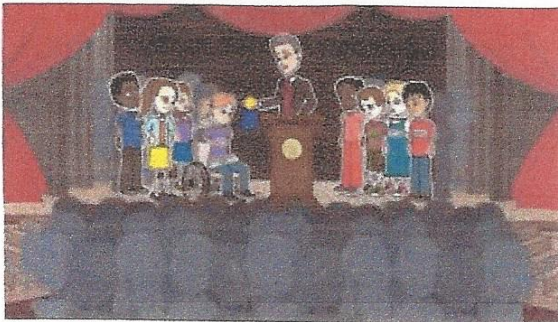
Please read and enjoy the novel Out of My Mind by Sharon Draper this summer.
