

## APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP (Minimum of \$500)

Eligibility: Applicants must be residents of Clark County and be at least half-time students (6 semester hours) enrolled in a public, private, or home school. Former applicants and/or scholarship recipients are eligible to re-apply in an effort to receive additional scholarship consideration. Priority may be given to applicants who have been or are currently involved in any activities connected with the performing arts and/or plan to pursue such activities in the near future.

## SUBMISSIONS <u>MUST</u> INCLUDE THIS FORM <u>IN ADDITION TO THE FOLLOWING</u> IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED:

- Current validated school transcripts reflecting coursework completed
- One (1) or more letters of support from (an) academic staff member(s)
- At least one (1) letter reflecting acceptance for admission to an accredited post-secondary institution in a two-year technical or associate program or a four-year degree program
- A one-page statement outlining your career goals including any objectives for future activity
  with the performing arts as well as why you believe you should be awarded a Rose Island
  Playhouse scholarship. Be specific.

NOTE: Applications that do not include <u>all</u> of the requirements listed above will <u>not</u> be considered.
